
Notice on Extra-Curricular Activities 2018-19 No.111B
(To : All Students)

In order to widen the horizon of students and let students enjoy all-rounded education in our school, we are organizing various kinds of after-school interest classes for them. The contents of different activities and application forms have been attached with this circular and parents are advised to take note of the following application procedures.

Procedures	Date	Remarks
1) After-school interest classes application	From 4/1/19 to 8/1/19	- Enrollment guideline: For the continuity of the activities, students joined the same class in the first term have the priority to enroll. Application form and course fee have to be handed in to the class teacher on or before 4/1. - Remaining seats will be allocated on a first-come-first-served basis. - School reserves all the right of allocation of seats. - Course fee is non-refundable except classes being cancelled due to inadequate enrollment.
2) Admission notice for After-school interest classes.	21/1/19-24/1/19	Admission notice will be attached on the student handbook p.38-39. Unsuccessful applicants will be notified for the refund.
3) Final round application	25/1/19	Unsuccessful applicants can re-apply with Miss Tam to join those classes still with vacancies on a first-come-first-serve basis.

Please also take note of the followings:

1. Payment in cash or by cheque. Cheque should be made payable to "The IMC of Chiu Sheung School, Hong Kong". Please write the student's name, class and parent's telephone number at the back of the cheque. **Each cheque is for applying 1 activity only.**
 2. The swimming class will be held in February this year, please refer to the swimming circular for details.
 3. Students are advised to take part in two activities at most, so they can have enough time for schoolwork and take a balanced schedule at leisure.
 4. Students should wear school uniform/ sports uniform when they attend the class on Saturday.
 5. Interest class tutors are working on a contract base appointment with the school. They are not allowed to take extra charge from the students or to lead students to join public competitions without prior written approval from the school.
 6. All interest classes are to be financially responsible for profits or losses, any profit or loss balance will be put under the extra-curricular activity account. The money in this account will be used on students' activity affairs.
 7. Please keep the appendix as a reference. Parents can contact the teacher-in-charge for enquiries.
 8. The training will be cancelled if Typhoon No. 8 or above, Red/Black Rainstorm signal is hoisted within two hours from the training starting time, or the Education Bureau advises primary schools in the whole territory or individual districts to suspend classes. Make up classes or refund will be made by School. All classes will normally be held as scheduled when Typhoon Signal No. 3 or below is hoisted or when Amber Rainstorm Signal is in force.
 9. Returned the reply slip to the class teacher on or before 8th January even if your child does not apply the interest classes.
