Notice on 'One Person, One Flower' Scheme 2021-2022 No. e077B (To: All students)

To promote a green culture among students, to cultivate their interest in growing plants and to raise their concerns to the community, our school has joined the 'One Person, One Flower' Scheme organized by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department.

Participants can bring back home <u>the seedlings of Viola tricolor (Pansy) for free</u> and enjoy the planting process. They need to bring the plant to school for display purposes in January or February next year. Details are as follows:

Date of distribution: 8/12 (P.1-2), 9/12 (P.3-4), 10/12 (P.5-6)

Planting method:

- 1. The optimum growth temperature of Pansy is 12-20°C.
- 2. It should be exposed to sunlight for at least 4 hours every day.
- 3. During planting, a well-ventilated environment should be maintained.
- 4. Sufficient moist should be kept during its growth and flowering periods.

Program fee:

The seedlings are free of charge.

\$10 is charged for the pot and potting mix.

Remarks:

- 1. Please bring a plastic bag for taking the plant home.
