(To : All Students)


In order to widen the students' horizon and let them enjoy all-rounded education in school, we are organizing various kinds of after-school interest classes for them. Due to the COVID-19 epidemic, interest classes held on Monday to Friday will be arranged online by Zoom, while interest classes held on Saturday are face-to-face lessons. The contents of different activities have been attached with this circular and parents are advised to take note of the following application procedures.

1) Application period for the after-school interest classes	3/1/22-6/1/22	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Students who are interested in joining the classes have to apply the interest class through the "eClass eEnrolment system".</li> <li>- All seats will be allocated by the system. For over enrolment, the system will allocate the seats randomly.</li> <li>- In order to allow parents to have enough time to consider, the registration process <u>starts at 9 a.m. on 3/1 and ends at 5 p.m. on 6/1</u>. Please note that parents can register and modify the choices during this period.</li> <li>- There is a <u>demonstration video</u> on how to register for interest classes in eClass app in appendix 1.</li> <li>- School reserves the right of allocation of seats.</li> </ul>
2) Admission notice for After-school interest classes and payment	12/1/22-18/1/22	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Admission notice will be issued to students on 12/1 who have successfully joined the class through eClass.</li> <li>- Parents must pay the fee on or before 18/1, otherwise the school will have the right to cancel the admission qualifications.</li> <li>- The login details of online lessons will be posted on student's handbook p.38 after payment.</li> <li>- All fees are non-refundable except for classes cancelled due to the suspension of classes announced by the Education Bureau.</li> <li>- If the number of participants does not meet the minimum requirement, the tuition fee will be adjusted or the class will not be held.</li> </ul>

Please also take note of the followings:

1. Payment by eClass payment system (Alipay) or by cheque. Cheque should be made payable to "The IMC of Chiu Sheung School, Hong Kong". Please write the student's name, class, parent's telephone number and name of interest class at the back of the cheque. Each cheque is for applying 1 activity only.
2. Interest classes held on Monday to Friday will be arranged online by Zoom, while interest classes held on Saturday are face-to-face lessons. Once the Education Bureau announced resumption of whole day face-to-face class arrangements, the date of interest classes will be unchanged, however the time and location will be changed. See appendix 1.
3. The school will take appropriate anti-epidemic measures during sports activities according to the recommendations of the Centre for Health Protection. When students are engaged in low-intensity physical activities in indoor venues, such as table tennis, students should wear masks and will be arranged to maintain a social distance of at least 1 meter. Students are not required to wear masks during moderate or vigorous exercises such as basketball and football in outdoor venues. Students will be arranged to maintain a social distance of at least 1.5 meters.

4. If the Education Bureau announced resumption of whole day face-to-face class arrangements, the school bus services at 5 p.m. will be resumed also. Students who take the school bus from Monday to Friday can take the school bus at 5 p.m. There is no school bus service for interest classes held on Saturdays.
  5. Parents and students please keep the login details of online lessons carefully. Do not disclose the meeting ID, password and related information to others.
  6. In the online lessons, students have to enter their name and classes, and also turn on the video to show their face for recording attendance.
  7. In order to protect privacy, it is not allowed to record any video, audio, photos, screenshot or perform retransmission during the lessons.
  8. Students should wear school uniform/ sports uniform when they attend the class on Saturday.
  9. Students are advised to take part in three activities at most, so they can have enough time for schoolwork and take a balanced schedule at leisure.
  10. Interest class tutors are working on a contract base appointment with the school. They are not allowed to take extra charge from the students or to lead students to join public competitions without prior written approval from the school.
  11. All interest classes are to be financially responsible for profit or loss, any profit or loss balance will be put under the extra-curricular activity account. The money in this account will be used in students' activity affairs.
  12. Please keep the appendix as a reference. Parents can contact the teacher-in-charge for enquiries.
  13. The training will be cancelled if Typhoon No. 8 or above, Red/Black Rainstorm signal is hoisted within two hours from the training starting time, or the Education Bureau advises primary schools in the whole territory or individual districts to suspend classes. Make up classes or refund will be made by School. All classes will normally be held as scheduled when Typhoon Signal No. 3 or below is hoisted or when Amber Rainstorm Signal is in force.
  14. Return the reply slip on or before 5<sup>th</sup> January even if your child does not apply the interest classes.
