Dear Parents/Guardians,

Notice on Resumption of Face-to-Face Classes after the Easter holidays 2021/2022 No.e138B
(To: All students)

In view of the latest development trend of the Covid-19 epidemic, the Education Bureau announced that all schools in Hong Kong will resume face-to-face classes after the Easter holidays. Parents are advised to pay attention to the following arrangements:

1) Resumption of face-to-face classes:

- ✧ P.1 to P.6 will resume half day face-to-face classes from **25th April (Monday)**. The school time is 8:00 a.m. - 12:20p.m..
- ✧ The class teachers will contact parents by phone next week to remind about the arrangements and collect information that needs to be reported (anonymously) to the Education Bureau.

2) Summer school uniform:

- ✧ Students will have to wear summer uniform on the first day of classes resumption. Parents please prepare for the children.

3) The school's epidemic prevention measures:

- ✧ The school will continue to strictly implement the health guidelines of the Education Bureau and the Centre for Health Protection. Thorough cleaning and disinfection of the campus will be arranged before the resumption of classes.
- ✧ Application of Nano anti-virus coating on the indoor and outdoor areas of the school campus.
- ✧ The school has carried out indoor ventilation inspection during the holiday period and installed or replaced the exhaust fan to improve the ventilation effect.
- ✧ Installation of air purifiers and disinfectors in classrooms, teachers' rooms and other special rooms.

4) Vaccine Pass:

- ✧ The vaccine pass has been implemented in schools from 24th February. Please refer to the circular e121B issued earlier for details.
- ✧ Before entering the school, parents must scan the "Leave Home Safe" QR code and present their vaccination records for inspection.
- ✧ Parents who come to the school to pick up their students have to wait outside the school gate for the pick-up if they fail to show their vaccination records.

5) Daily Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) before coming to school:

- ✧ According to the instructions of the Education Bureau, **students must complete a rapid antigen test at home with a negative result before coming to school every day. They are not allowed to return to school if the test result is positive and should notify the school and report to the Department of Health as soon as possible.**

✧ Method of reporting results:

- On the first day of class resumption, please fill in the test result in the Correspondence box on the 25/4 (Monday) column of the student's homework diary according to the following with parent signature.

25/4 Result of RAT test is negative.

- Fill in the following if the student has been recovered from the Covid-19. Parents have to provide copy of the quarantine order from the Centre for Health Protection for the proof.

25/4 RAT test is exempted.

- From the second day after the resumption of classes, use the "**Rapid Antigen Test Negative Result Record**" form provided by the school in the homework diary.

- ✧ Parents may be requested to come to school to conduct the RAT again for students as needed. If a student lives with a family member who is infected with COVID-19, he or she will be regarded as a close contact and cannot return to school. He or she must follow the instructions of the Department of Health and complete the quarantine order before returning to school.
- ✧ Please prepare the "RAT Negative Result Record" form for inspection before arrive at school. Students who take the school bus must present the RAT record form to the nanny for inspection before boarding the school bus.
- ✧ Student will not be able to attend the class and the school will notify the parents to pick up the student if the student forgot to bring the RAT record form or the parents did not sign it. In addition, for the reason of safety and health, the school will not take the initiative to help students with the RAT testing.
- ✧ In order to protect the health and safety of all students and staff, the above measures will be observed strictly. Parents are requested to pay attention and be cooperative to help students reserve enough time in the morning to take the RAT test and sign the record form.

6) RAT test kits:

- ✧ The Education Bureau will provide free one month usage of RAT test kits for families who are receiving the **CSSA or full / half-subsidy of Student Financial Assistance**. Parents are reminded to take the initiative to inform the class teacher during telephone conversation.
- ✧ Our school sponsoring body, The Hong Kong Chiu Chow Chamber of Commerce and other organisations will also donate limited number of RAT test kits and kid's face masks to all students. They will be distributed to students on the first day of classes resumption.


7) Collection of data of vaccination and infection:

- ✧ According to the guidance of the Education Bureau, schools are required to report (anonymously) the vaccination and infection statistics of students. Class teachers will inquire about the details during the call.

8) Arrangements for tutorial classes, after-school interest classes and school team training:

- ✧ Tutorial classes will be suspended for the first week of class resumption.
- ✧ After-school interest classes (Monday to Saturday paid classes) will resume from 25/4 and will continue to be conducted online. Parents are requested to supervise your children to attend the class according to the date and time in "Appendix 1".
- ✧ Due to the relevant vaccination requirements for non-academic activities, the training of pop band, puppetry and percussion band still need to be suspended after the Easter holiday. Face-to-face classes will resume after enough students have completed two doses of the vaccine with more than 14 days.
- ✧ English drama will continue with online classes. Likewise, face-to-face training will resume when enough students have completed two doses of vaccine with more than 14 days.

Parents' attention and cooperation is highly appreciated with the aim to provide a safe and healthy school environment for students after class resumption.
