Dear Parents/Guardians,

Notice on "COVID-19 Vaccination Overview for Students" 2022-2023 No.006B
(To: All Students)

In order to protect the health of teachers and students at school, parents/guardians are requested to continue to take the temperature of their children and conduct rapid antigen tests for students every morning. Parents please sign the "Rapid Antigen Test Negative Result Record" for confirmation. When students return to school each day, they must present the record to the teacher for inspection.

Strengthening of the "Vaccine Pass" function - Amber and Red code:


- From 9 August, school staff/students with the "Amber Code" (people arriving in Hong Kong from overseas places or Taiwan) are not allowed to participate in any mask-off activities at school. Since primary students are exempted from using "LeaveHomeSafe" when entering the school premises, parents must take the initiative to report their children's "Red Code" or "Amber Code" status to the school. Students having "Amber Code" can return to school after obtaining a negative rapid antigen test on each school day.
- Parents or students having "Red Code" (that is, confirmed cases) are not allowed to enter the school premise.

According to the circular issued by the Education Bureau regarding individual students who have received two doses of vaccine for more than 14 days, schools may arrange these students to stay at school after lessons or the other half-day for non-academic extra-curricular activities (e.g. music and sports activities, school team training, etc.). These students may also participate in some mask off activities (e.g. playing woodwind instruments, "contact" sports such as football and basketball, etc.) at school (including both in-class and after-class activities).

To further strengthen the protective barrier of schools, starting from 1st October, 2022, the related requirements will be stepped up. Students will be required to have received three doses of vaccine. The above arrangements are not applicable to students aged 5 to 11 years who are required to receive only two doses of BioNTech vaccine, and students with prior COVID-19 infection who are not required to take the third dose of vaccine. Students who have received two doses of vaccine but are still within the time interval waiting to receive the third dose should, by following the CHP's recommendation, receive the third dose of vaccine within one week upon their being eligible to do so.

Vaccination is the most effective safeguard measure as it can prevent severe cases and reduce the risk of fatalities effectively. We encourage students to receive the third dose by following the latest Government recommendation in order to achieve comprehensive and enhanced protection.

In order to effectively plan school activities, please return the information by 5th September. Please also update the class teacher accordingly for any change in the future. All information is strictly confidential.
