Notice on Extra-Curricular Activities 2022-23 No.e036B  
(To : All Students)

In order to widen the students' horizon and let them enjoy all-rounded education in school, we are organizing various kinds of after-school interest classes for them. The contents of different activities have been attached with this circular and parents are advised to take note of the following application procedures.

1) Application period for the after-school interest classes	13/9/22-16/9/22	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Students who are interested in joining the classes have to apply the interest class through the " eClass eEnrolment system".</li> <li>- All seats will be allocated by the system. For over enrolment, the system will allocate the seats randomly.</li> <li>- To allow for enough time to consider, the registration process starts at 9 a.m. on 13/9 and ends at 5 p.m. on 16/9. Please note that parents can register and modify the choices during this period.</li> </ul>
2) Admission notice for After-school interest classes and payment	28/9/22-5/10/22	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- E-admission notice will be issued to students on 28/9 who have successfully joined the class through eClass.</li> <li>- Payment notice will be issued to students on 5/10. Parents must pay the fee on or before 5/10, otherwise the school will have the right to cancel the admission qualifications.</li> <li>- Students of basketball and football classes must fulfill the new vaccination requirements for participating in mask-off activities, please refer to Note 4 for the handling. They have to submit a copy of the vaccination record or diagnosis record to the class teacher before 16/9. If students have already handed in to the class teacher, they do not need to hand in again.</li> <li>- Parents of Parent-child Gardening classes must submit a copy of the vaccination record or diagnosis record to the class teacher before 16/9. Parents must scan the "Leave Home Safe" QR code when they enter the school and present their Blue Code for inspection.</li> <li>- Final admission notice will be attached on the student handbook p.40-41 before 14/10.</li> <li>- If the number of participants does not meet the minimum requirement, the tuition fee will be adjusted or the class will be cancelled.</li> <li>- All fees are non-refundable except for classes cancelled due to the suspension of classes announced by the Education Bureau.</li> </ul>

Please also take note of the followings:

1. Payment by eClass payment system (Alipay) or by cheque. Cheque should be made payable to "The IMC of Chiu Sheung School, Hong Kong". Please write the student's name, class, parent's telephone number and name of interest class at the back of the cheque. Each cheque is for applying 1 activity only.
2. All interest classes are face-to-face lessons. Once the Education Bureau announced resumption of whole day face-to-face class arrangements, the date and venue of interest classes will be unchanged, however the time will be changed. See appendix 1.

3. The school will take appropriate anti-epidemic measures during sports activities according to the recommendations of the Centre for Health Protection. When students are engaged in low-intensity physical activities in indoor venues, such as table tennis, students should wear masks and will be arranged to maintain a social distance of at least 1 meter. Students are not required to wear masks during moderate or vigorous exercises such as basketball and football in outdoor venues. Students will be arranged to maintain a social distance of at least 1.5 meters. Students with the "Amber Code" are not allowed to participate in any mask-off activities at school, parents must take the initiative to report their children's "Amber Code" status to the school.
4. According to the guidance of the Education Bureau, starting from 1 October 2022, students who have received the third dose of vaccination for more than 14 days, they will be allowed to participate in activities that require student to take off masks, excluding those students aged 5 to 11 who are required to receive only two doses of BioNTech vaccines, and students with prior COVID-19 infection who are not required to take the third dose of vaccine. If student has been infected, according to the guidelines of the Centre for Health Protection, the number of vaccine doses is calculated as follows:
  - People who have been infected with Covid-19 will need one less dose of the vaccine than the general population.
  - If a recovered student has received the first dose of vaccine at least 14 days before the infection, he/she will be considered as having completed two doses of vaccine. Such student should receive one more dose in order to meet the requirement of receiving three doses of vaccine.
  - For a student who has never received COVID-19 vaccine, he/she can be vaccinated after 30 days from the date of the recovery. If a student has received two doses of COVID-19 vaccine before infection, he/she will be considered as having received three doses of vaccine.
  - For a student who has already taken two doses but is still within the time interval waiting to receive the third dose, he/she will be considered as meeting the third-dose requirement for the time being but the student concerned must take the third dose within one week after he/she is eligible to do so.  
#If students could not meet the third-dose requirement for the time being, they are not allowed to participate mask-off activities. And the tuition fee will not be refunded.
5. Students must complete a rapid antigen test and sign in the record at home with a negative result before coming to school every day. They are not allowed to return to school if the test result is positive and should notify the school and report to the Department of Health as soon as possible. Parents have to sign on the "Rapid Antigen Test Negative Result Record". If students return to school on Saturday to participate in any activities, they must also take a rapid antigen test which must be signed by their parents on the "Rapid Antigen Test Negative Result Record".
6. Due to the epidemic, the Education Bureau announced that all primary schools need to implement half day school. there will be no school bus service after schools from Monday to Saturday. The students will be dismissed at the main entrance of the school. Parents need to pick up accordingly.
7. If the Education Bureau announces that all primary schools will resume whole day school, students who use the school bus service from Monday to Friday can take the 5:00p.m. school bus to go home. P1 students will be dismissed at the main entrance of the school. P2 to P6 students will be dismissed at Hill Road.
8. Students should wear school uniform/ sports uniform when they attend the class on Saturday.
9. Students are advised to take part in three activities at most, so they can have enough time for schoolwork and take a balanced schedule at leisure.
10. Interest class tutors are working on a contract base appointment with the school. They are not allowed to take extra charge from the students or to lead students to join public competitions without prior written approval from the school.
11. All interest classes are to be financially responsible for profit or loss, any profit or loss balance will be put under the extra-curricular activity account. The money in this account will be used in students' activity affairs.

12. Please keep the appendix as a reference. Parents can contact the teacher-in-charge for enquiries.
13. The training will be cancelled if Typhoon No. 8 or above, Red/Black Rainstorm signal is hoisted, or the Education Bureau advises primary schools in the whole territory or individual districts to suspend classes. Make up classes or refund will be made by School. All classes will normally be held as scheduled when Typhoon Signal No. 3 or below is hoisted or when Amber Rainstorm Signal is in force.
14. Return the reply slip on or before 16<sup>th</sup> September even if your child does not apply the interest classes.
