Notice on Extra-Curricular Activities (Whole year) 2023-24 No.e035B
(To: All Students)

In order to widen students' horizon and let them enjoy all-rounded education in school, we are organizing various kinds of after-school interest classes for them. Start from this year, there will only be two enrollment periods for interest classes, they will be in September and June respectively. The contents of different activities have been attached with this circular and parents are advised to take note of the following application procedures.

1) Application period for the after-school interest classes	12/9/2023- 14/9/2023	 Students who are interested in joining the classes have to apply for them through the "eClass eEnrolment system". All seats will be allocated by the system. For over enrolment, the system will allocate the seats randomly. To allow parents to have enough time to consider the classes, the registration process will start at 9 a.m. on 12/9 and ends at 5 p.m. on 14/9. Please note that parents can register and modify their choices during this period.
2) Admission notice for After- school interest classes and payment	25/9/2023- 3/10/2023	 Payment notice will be issued to students on 25/9 who have successfully joined the class through eClass. Parents must pay the fee on or before 3/10, otherwise the school will have the right to cancel the admission qualifications. The final admission notice will be attached on p.40-41 of the student handbook before 13/10. If the number of participants does not meet the minimum requirement, the tuition fee will be adjusted or the class will be cancelled. All fees are non-refundable except for classes that are cancelled due to the suspension of classes announced by the Education Bureau.

Please also take note of the followings:

- 1. Payments should br made through the eClass payment system (Alipay) or by cheque. The cheque should be made payable to "The IMC of Chiu Sheung School, Hong Kong". Please write the student's name, class, parent's telephone number and name of the interest class at the back of the cheque. Each cheque is for applying 1 activity only. If you will settle the payment by Alipay, please note that the daily transfer limit for accounts that have not completed the identity verification is HK\$3,000. If parents need to pay more than HK\$3,000, please note that you need two days to finish the transactions.
- 2. There will be no school bus service after schools on from Monday to Saturday. Please pay attention to the place of dismissal below:

- 3. Students should wear school uniform/ sports uniform when they attend the class on Saturday.
- 4. Students are advised to take part in <u>three activities at most</u>, so they can have enough time for schoolwork and take a balanced schedule at leisure.
- 5. Interest class tutors are working on a contract base appointment with the school. They are not allowed to take extra charge from the students or to lead students to join public competitions without prior written approval from the school.
- 6. All interest classes are to be financially responsible for profit or loss, any profit or loss balance will be put under the extra-curricular activity account. The money in this account will be used in students' activity affairs.
- 7. Please keep the appendix as a reference. Parents can contact the teacher-in-charge for enquiries.
- 8. The training will be cancelled if Typhoon No. 8 or above, Red/Black Rainstorm signal is hoisted, or the Education Bureau advises primary schools in the whole territory or individual districts to suspend classes. Make up classes or refund will be made by School. All classes will normally be held as scheduled when Typhoon Signal No. 3 or below is hoisted or when Amber Rainstorm Signal is in force.
- 9. Return the reply slip on or before 14th September even if your child will not apply for any of the interest classes.
